## Psychology and social problems of the characters in the novel "Sincerely Yours, Shurik"

Ulitskaya- very famous modern Russian writer. Her works have been translated into many languages and published in many countries. Her three works - "Childhood 49", " Sonechka", " Sincerely Yours, Shurik " - have already been published in Taiwan.

The works of L. Ulitskaya are very popular around the world. The writer was honored with such awards as the Russian "Booker Prize" and French "Medici Prize" for best foreign works, as well as many others. Recently Ulitskaya receiving more and more attention from literary critics. It is called a representative of the modern "women's prose" and "Family Chronicle" (work "Sonechka", "Kukotsky's Case ", "Medea and Her Children" and others).

This thesis is devoted to the analysis of the product, "Sincerely Yours, Shurik", in her study a new style of the writer, is qualitatively different from the style of her previous novels. In this work Ulitskaya waives its inherent creativity at an early stage of sentimentalism, is also changing its way of describing events in the Soviet Union, its relation to Soviet history, psychology and sociology are transformed for the better, in addition, she openly and realistically describes the relationship between a man and a woman. The present author believes that the novel L.
